

how to mix colors

to make this color use this Americolor soft gel paste

TIPS:

Always start with **one drop** and add more as needed.

Some colors will take lots of drops, some only one.

For different shades of the same color, simply add more and more drops.

When mixing two colors, always start with one drop of each and add more as needed
